

Activate Driving Focus to Come on Automatically (iOS 15.0 and later)

Step 1: Tap the Settings app.



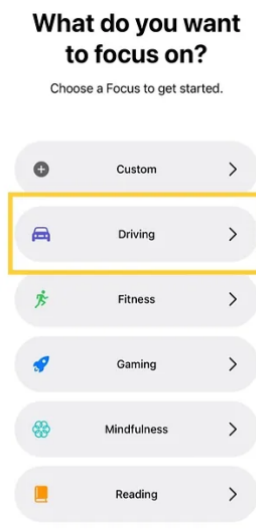
Step 2: Scroll and tap Focus.



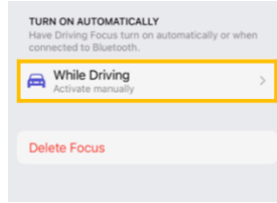
Step 3: Tap the + (plus) icon in the upper right-hand corner.



Step 4: When "What do you want to focus on?" pops up, tap Driving.



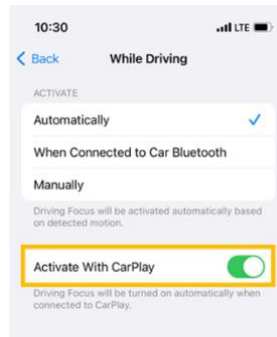
Step 5: Tap While Driving.



Step 6: Tap Automatically so that Driving Focus will turn on automatically when your phone detects that you are driving.



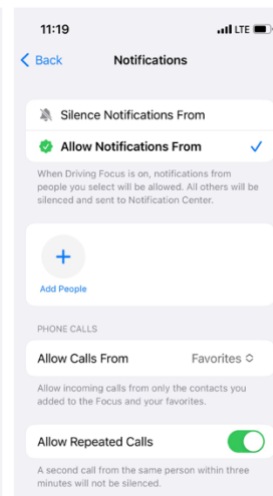
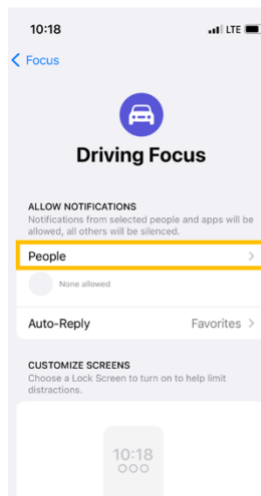
Step 7: Have Apple CarPlay? Tap the slider next to Activate With CarPlay to automatically activate Driving Focus when connected to CarPlay.



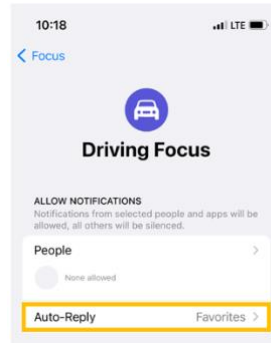
Customize Your Driving Focus Settings

Step 1: Go back to Settings > Focus > Driving.

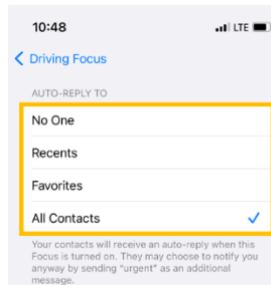
Step 2: Tap People and use the next screen to add contacts whom you want to see notifications from or receive calls from when Driving Focus is active.



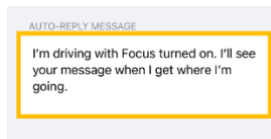
Step 3: Tap Auto-Reply.



3a. Select who you want auto-reply messages sent to when Driving Focus is active by tapping No One, Recents, Favorites, or All Contacts.



3b. Tap on the default message in the AUTO-REPLY MESSAGE section to customize the auto-reply message.



Step 4: Choose a Lock Screen to turn on when Driving Focus is active to reduce distractions.
