Penn Medicine's Center for Health Care Transformation and Innovation (CHTI) is launching a **Nursing Transformation Fellow** role for experienced nurses who want to apply their clinical expertise beyond the bedside to improve care delivery across the health system.

This **one-year, hybrid, part-time fellowship** is designed for full-time nurses who are energized by solving complex problems and translating frontline insight into real, scalable change. As a Fellow, you would:

- **Lead and test innovative care models** from design through implementation and scaling.
- **Serve as an embedded transformation leader**, partnering with clinical and operational teams to improve quality, access, and equity.
- **Bring a nursing lens to system-level decisions**, shaping workflows, care transitions, and patient experiences across Penn Medicine.

This role may be a strong fit if you're an experienced nurse who enjoys systems thinking, project ownership, and influencing change—and you're curious about applying your clinical expertise in a new, high-impact way. The work will require several days a week of on-site presence in Penn Medicine's downtown hospitals.
